Zena R. Mello is a Professor of Psychology. She completed a Postdoctoral Fellowship in Cognition and Development at the University of California, Berkeley, a Ph.D. and an M.S. in Human Development and Family Studies from the Pennsylvania State University, and a B.A. in Psychology from the University of California, Santa Cruz. She has been honored with an Outstanding Dissertation Award from the Human Development Division of the American Educational Research Association. She has published extensively in leading journals and is recognized as one of his field's most highly cited researchers in the theory and measurement of time perspective.
